Self Assessment Notice to complete a tax return

This message was sent to you on 06 April 2022

You need to file a Self Assessment tax return for the 2021 to 2022 tax year if you haven't already. The tax year ended on 5 April 2022.

You must file your online return by 31 January 2023.

If you've already completed your tax return for the 2021 to 2022 tax year, or we've told you that you don't need to send us a 2021 to 2022 tax return, you don't need to do anything else.

You can [pay through your Pay As You Earn tax code \(https://www.gov.uk/pay-self-assessment-tax-bill/through-your-tax-code\)](https://www.gov.uk/pay-self-assessment-tax-bill/through-your-tax-code) if you owe less than £3,000 (you'll need to file by 30 December 2022).

By law, you need to complete your tax return, even if you've already paid all the tax you owe, or you think you don't owe any tax. You can check if you need to send a tax return using our [online tool \(https://www.gov.uk/check-if-you-need-tax-return\)](https://www.gov.uk/check-if-you-need-tax-return).

Start your return now

The sooner you get started the better - it can take time to gather all the information you need. Start [filling in your return online \(https://www.gov.uk/log-in-file-self-assessment-tax-return\)](https://www.gov.uk/log-in-file-self-assessment-tax-return).

You'll have to buy [commercial software \(https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/self-assessment-commercial-software-suppliers\)](https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/self-assessment-commercial-software-suppliers) if you need to send a partnership or trust and estate tax return online, or if you're a minister of religion or lived abroad as a non-resident.

If you need to fill in a Partnership tax return

If this notice is in the name of a particular partner, by law that partner must send the tax return, along with any other information we ask for.

If this notice is in the name of the partnership, the other members of the partnership can nominate one partner, who must by law complete and file the tax return. If the partners can't nominate someone, they should ask us to do so.

If you're late completing your tax return, you may have to pay a penalty
